



## Logistic Operations

The ultimate goal of any logistics operation is to move a product from supplier to customer – this path is called the supply chain, and it needs to keep moving in order for goods to arrive at the right place, at the right time.

In a Logistics role you will play an important role in all of this, liaising with a range of people including suppliers, manufacturers, retailers and consumers.

As an apprentice, your duties may involve transportation, stock control, warehousing and/or monitoring the flow of goods and materials. If you are a manager you will take responsibility for the day to day running. You'll be responsible for the day-to-day running of things and making sure that quality, cost and efficiency of the supply chain meets standards.

You'll learn a range of skills, which could include monitoring stock and keep records; managing the receipt, storage or dispatch of goods; developing relationships with customers and suppliers; and providing leadership for your team.

For this role, you'll need strong organisation skills. You'll also need to be able to think on your feet and make quick decisions.
